CARPOOL MARKET IN INDIA

India has about 70 million cars on the road. The global carpooling market is estimated at \$15 billion today, a number expected to reach \$335 billion by 2025, according to a research paper from PricewaterhouseCoopers.

In the carpooling segment, the market opportunity is enormous in India.

With a population of about 25 Million, Delhi alone has at least 10 Million commutable journeys. This is just one city; the amount may be at least 60 percent for the rest of India.

Quick Ride's primary objective is to reduce vehicles in Tier I cities & then gradually penetrate Tier II and Tier III towns to relieve traffic congestion & thus lower levels of pollution.
